# Environmental Policy

## Introduction

The Cleanevent Group is committed to environmental best practice and to the continual improvement of its environmental performance, recognising its obligations both locally and globally to the present and succeeding generations.

The Cleanevent Group is also committed to implementing the requirements of all applicable Commonwealth, State and local environmental legislation and regulations and raising the environmental awareness of its employees, clients, suppliers and the public by promoting concepts of ecological sustainability.

Acceptance of this policy, as well as the organisation's other policies and work procedures, is implied in the organisation's conditions of employment and engagement.

## Scope

This policy applies to all Cleanevent Group employees, contractors, subcontractors, consultants and to the Group's activities and at all its sites.

## Environmental Management

The Cleanevent Group commits itself to establishing and maintaining a formal environmental management system in accordance with this policy. This will be done by focusing on the following key areas;

### Pollution and Waste

The Cleanevent Group is committed to recycling and disposing waste in environmentally acceptable ways. The Group is also committed to waste avoidance, waste reduction and re-use of materials wherever practical.

### Procurement

The Cleanevent Group will regularly monitor and review wherever practical, its acquisition of goods and services. When services, chemicals, supplies, equipment or energy are purchased, preference will be given to items produced in ways which cause least harm to the environment and which generate fewest waste materials. Equipment designed for "repairability" rather than planned obsolescence will be favoured. All things being equal, preference will be given to local suppliers or sub-contractors so as to promote links with the community and to reduce transport needs.

### Environmental Awareness

The Cleanevent Group is committed to the promotion of awareness of environmental issues and the promotion of environmental sustainability, recognising the influence it has as a supplier of cleaning and waste management services. The group is also committed to working in co-operation with government, industry and the community at large to address environmental issues in general.
